

Full paper Submission Guidelines

11th ABC, 2026:

(I) The paper must be original and in consonance with the areas proposed to be covered in the Conference Flyer. The similarity index after checking plagiarism with software like Turnitin should not exceed 30%.

(II) The cover page of the paper should include the Title, Name, Designation, Institutional Address, Phone/ Mobile Number, and Email Address of each author.

(III) The paper to be submitted should be organized generally into the following sections:

Abstract (within 300 words) and Full Paper (within 5000 words)

Keywords: 3-5

JEL Classification/ Code: At least One (01)

1. Introduction: Stating the Background and Problem
2. Literature Review
3. Objectives and Hypotheses
4. Methodological Issues
5. Results and Discussion
6. Findings and Policy Implications
7. Conclusion

References: Use American Psychological Association (APA) Referencing Style and ensure that all the references should be both in the text of the paper and the reference section as well

Appendix/ Appendices (if any)

Acknowledgment (If required)

(IV) Prescribed Formatting:

- Paper size: A4 Size (wide 8.5" and long 11")
- Margins: Top= 1", Bottom= 1", Left= 1", Right= 1"
- Font Name: Times New Roman
- All paragraphs must be justified, i.e., both left-justified and right-justified.
- Line Spacing: 1.5
- The length of the manuscripts should not exceed 30 pages, including footnotes, references, appendices, charts, figures, and tables
- All the Figures and Tables must be in Black-and-White in Colour
- Sources must be mentioned below each Table and Figure of the article
- Page numbers must be included
- The paper must be submitted in MS Word version
